### **Clubwomen Competition**

All clubwomen are eligible to compete in visual arts, crafts, needlework, photography, literature, sewing for self, children or infants, drama, and public speaking. Clubwomen must not be professionals: earnings cannot exceed \$500 annually in a specific contest category. All work must have been completed in the year preceding the festival. Clubwomen may enter as many items as they want in any contest category, but only first place winning entries will be eligible to compete at the district and state levels. Information on contest categories can be obtained from the Clubwomen Competition Coordinators listed above.

### **Student Competition**

Students (at Pamlico County public and private schools, Arapahoe Charter School, and home schooled) are eligible to compete in visual arts, crafts, photography, literature, sewing, drama, public speaking, vocal, piano, and other instruments. Information on contest categories can be obtained from the Student Coordinator listed above.

### **Clubwomen Display/Sale**

Clubwomen who do not want to or cannot participate in the Clubwomen Competition are encouraged to bring their arts and crafts items to display and/or sell during the festival Open House. Arrangements should be made with the Chairman listed above.

### **Artfest**

Artfest is a separate competition for youth and adults with developmental disabilities. OWC supports adults from the NC Caswell Developmental Disabilities Center in Kinston and youth from Focus Therapy in Bayboro in this competition.
