

**Oriental Woman's Club Garden Club**  
**June 19, 2018 Minutes**  
**(corrected minutes)**

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Betsy Hughes at 9:30 am at the clubhouse.

As we no longer have our own bank account, these are necessary items to be placed in OWC's budget. After discussion it was decided that the Garden Club would contribute as follows:

- Plant Sale (averaging \$180 - \$210 income)
- Yard of the Month Award for December (\$25 local donation)
- Betsy will get quotes for hauling off debris piled at edge of property (expense)

There is a vacancy for August Yard of the Month judging. Carol Herman has signed up and needs another member. Lynne Kaplan volunteered. Meeting was adjourned at 11:15 am.
